Summary of the role:

- Investigate claims by interviewing claimants and inspecting physical damage.
- Set loss reserves, if applicable.
- Prepare reports by collecting and summarizing information required by the client, local, state and federal level of the government and Crawford®.

Is the SkillBridge (SKB) the same as the Career Skills Program (CSP)?

The Department of Defense (DoD) uses both terms interchangeably. SkillBridge provides eligible military members an opportunity to develop skills through civilian-on-the-job training, where members can gain essential employment skills through apprenticeships and internships to help them prepare to transition from the military to civilian employment.

When am I eligible to participate in the SkillBridge Training Program?

Service members can participate in SkillBridge training 180 days before their separation or retirement date. This can also depend on the length of their approved training programs.
